Bruffels, Jan. 29. Our Governor General is new at Glent; from whence he is not expected back here till the end of this week. His Excellency has ordered 700 Horses to be provided for the Service of the Artillery, and other preparations are likewile making for an early Campagne. The French are catting up tome new Fortifications between Pone a Chin and Pont a Tressin. The Great Council of this City hath contented to the Extraordinary Subtidies lately granted by the States of Brabant.

The Heer Van Spaen, Licu-Hague, Febr. 3. tenant General of the Brandenburg Forces, who came hither the last week, is returned to Cleves, after having had several Conferences with the Ministers here. The Count de Berka is expected in few days, to affift on the part of the Emperor at the Meeting of the Allies. And we near that the Baron Gars comes with the like Committion from the Landgrave of Heffe Callel. The Deputies of the Admiralties are gone home, but with intention to return hither again against the meeting of the States of Holland, who are adjourned to the 7th of this Mouth. The Letters by an Express from Ausbeurg, give an account of the Election of the King of the Remans on the 24th past, who was to be Crowned the 26th; and on the 4th Instant the Imperial Court would part from thence for Vienna.
