IV c. 71 put in force in Gibraltar by this Ordinance as has been repealed in England by the Imperial Act 37 and 38 Vic. c. 35.
1835 14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 27 intituled "An Act for the limitation of actions and suits relating to real property and for simplifying the remedies for trying the rights thereto."	So much of the Imperial Act 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 27 put in force in Gibraltar by this Ordinance as has been repealed in England by the Imperial Acts 37 and 38 Vic. c. 35—37 and 38 Vic. c. 57 and 42 and 43 Vic. c. 59.
14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 42 intituled "An Act for the further amendment of the law and the better advancement of Justice."	So much of the Imperial Act 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 42 put in force in Gibraltar by this Ordinance as has been repealed in England by the Imperial Acts 30 and 31 Vic. c. 142—37 and 38 Vic. c. 35 and 42 and 43 Vic. c. 59.
14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 74 intituled "An Act for the abolition of fines and recoveries and for the substitution of modes of assurance."	So much of the Imperial Act 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 74 put in force in Gibraltar by this Ordinance as has been repealed in England by the Imperial Acts 37 and 38 Vic. c. 35—38 and 39 Vic. c. 66 and 42 and 43 Vic. c. 78.
14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 49 intituled "An Act to allow Quakers and Moravians to make affirmations in all cases where an oath is or shall be required," and 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 82 intituled "An Act to allow the people called Separatists to make affirmations or solemn declarations instead of an oath."	So much of the Imperial Act 3 and 4 Wm. IV c. 49 put in force in Gibraltar by this Ordinance as has been repealed in England by the Imperial Act 34 and 35 Vic. c. 48.
14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 4 and 5 Wm. IV c. 23 intituled "An Act for the amendment of the law relative to the escheat and forfeiture of real and personal property holden in trust."	The whole.
14 <sup>th</sup> March ...	Ordinance putting in force 4 and 5 Wm. IV c. 67 intituled "An Act to abolish capital punishment in cases of returning from transportation."	The whole.
1836 16 <sup>th</sup> February ..	Ordinance putting in force so much of 5 and 6 Wm. IV c. 33 intituled "An Act for preventing the vexatious removal of indictments into the Court of King's Bench, &c. &c. &c."	The whole
