Amendment of the Notice relating to the Bankruptcy Act, 1883, which appeared in the Supplement to the London Gazette of the 28th December, 1883.

WE, the undersigned, being two of the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury, in pursuance of the provisions of the said Public Offices Fees Act, hereby direct that on and from the 14th day of July, 1884, the Fees, in respect of all proceedings in Bankruptcy in the High Court of Justice and the Court of Appeal, shall be collected by means of Bankruptcy Fee Stamps; and that on and from that date, Judicature Fee Stamps shall cease to be used for the purpose.
