The provisions of Chapter II (SPECIAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE METROPOLIS) of The Foot-and-Mouth Disease Temporary Order of 1884, together with all other provisions of that Order so far as the same relate to the provisions of that Chapter, are hereby revoked: Provided that nothing in this Order shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under any of those provisions before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed thereunder before the commencement of this Order.</p> <p>2.
