Gloucester Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Gloucester Union, in the City of Gloucester and County of the same City and County of Gloucester; And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS the Poor Law Commissioners, by a General Order bearing date the twenty-fourth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, made certain rules and regulations relating to the administration of relief to the Poor within certain Unions, including the said Gloucester Union; and by Articles 182 and 183 of the said
