part of the endowment of the said proposed new benefice.

"That all fees and ecclesiastical dues and payments for churchings marriages burials and other ecclesiastical offices solemnized and performed within the proposed separate parish and benefice and all such other ecclesiastical does offerings and emoluments other than tithe or tithe rent-charge usually payable to the incumbent of a parish or benefice as shall arise within the said proposed separate parish or benefice shall belong to the incumbent thereof.

"That the patronage of or right of nomination to the said proposed separate parish or benefice of Verwood and West Moors shall be vested in the Lord Bishop of Salisbury for the time being for

"That the inhabitants of the said proposed separate parish shall not be entitled after the passing of this scheme to accommodation in the parish churches of Cranborne and West Parley aforesaid, nor shall the parishioners of the parishes of Cranborne and West Parley respectively be entitled after the passing of this scheme to any accommodation in the church of Verwood.

"As witness my hand this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six.

"That the Right Reverend John Lord Bishop of Salisbury has represented unto us amongst

"That to the vicarage and parish church of Cranborne in the county of Dorset and diocese of Salisbury belongs a hamlet or place known by the name of Verwood comprising also a place and proposed is required in order to raise the

called Three Legged Cross otherwise Three Cross the limits and boundaries whereof are well known and defined.

"That to the rectory and parish church of West Parley in the said county of Dorset and diocese of Salisbury there belongs a hamlet or place known by the name of West Moors the limits and boundaries whereof are well known and defined.

"That it appears to the said Lord Bishop that the said hamlets of Verwood and Three Cross and West Moors respectively may be advantageously separated from the said vicarage and parish church of Cranborne and rectory and parish church of West Parley respectively and together be constituted a separate parish for ecclesiastical purposes and a perpetual curacy and benefice to be named Verwood and West Moors.

"That the said Lord Bishop has drawn up a scheme in writing describing the mode in which it appears to him the proposed alteration may best be effected and how the changes consequent upon such alteration in respect to ecclesiastical jurisdiction glebe lands tithe rent-charges dues rates and payments and in respect to patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested which scheme together with the consents thereto in writing of the patrons and incumbents of the benefices affected by such alteration has been transmitted by the said Lord Bishop to us for our consideration.

"The representation and scheme of the said Lord Bishop and the consents before referred to

are hereunto annexed.

"And we the said Archbishop being on full consideration and inquiry satisfied with the said scheme do hereby pursuant to the Act of the first and second years of Your Majesty's reign chapter 106 certify the same and such consents as aforesaid to Your Majesty in Council to the intent that Your Majesty in Council may in case Your Majesty in Council shall think fit so to do make and issue an Order for carrying the said scheme into effect.
