thousand eight hundred and forty-four to the annual sums of two hundred and fifteen pounds and eighty-six pounds respectively making together the sum of three hundred and one pounds together with the glebe and glebe rents belonging to the said rectory of Llanbeulan situate and arising within the said townships or chapelries of Llechylched and Ceirchiog and the monies received by the sale of a portion of the said glebe, particulars of which are as follows:—

"1. A tenement or farm called Lleinar Allor containing together five acres and seventeen roods or thereabouts situate in the said township or chapelry of Llechylched and now let to William

Owen at a yearly rent of six pounds.

"2. A tenement or farm called Penygroesion containing together two acres one rood and twenty perches or thereabouts situate in the said township or chapelry of Ceirchiog and now let to John Parry at a yearly rent of five pounds.

"3. A quillet being part of Penygroeslon aforesaid containing two roods and four perches or thereabouts and let to Richard Williams at a

yearly rent of ten shillings and

"4. A sum of £202 0s. 4d. Metropolitan £3 per centum Consolidated Stock standing in the names of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, and the said Commissioners have promised to grant to the said proposed separate parish and benefice out of their common fund a capital sum of one thousand five hundred pounds to be laid out and expended with the consent of the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners and of the Bishop of the diocese in or towards the erection of a parsonage-house for the said proposed separate parish and benefice.

"That pursuant to the direction contained in the twenty-sixth section of the said first-mentioned Act of Parliament I the said Lord Bishop of Bangor have drawn up a scheme in writing appended to this representation describing the mode in which it appears to me that the alterations above proposed may be best effected and how the changes consequent on such alteration in respect to ecclesiastical jurisdiction dues rates and payments and in respect to patronage and rights to pews may be made with justice to all parties interested.

And I do submit the same to your Grace, together with my consent in writing as patron and the consent of the said Robert Williams as rector of the said rectory of Llanbeulan to the intent that your Grace may, if on full consideration and inquiry you shall be satisfied with the said scheme certify the same and such consent to Her Majesty in Council. "J. C. Bangor."

And whereas the said scheme drawn up by the said Lord Bishop of Bangor, and the consents referred to in the said representation are as follows:—

" SCHEME.

"That the said townships or chapelries of Llechylched and Ceirchiog be separated from the said rectory and parish and parish churches of Llanbeulan and be constituted together a separate parish for all ecclesiastical purposes and a perpetual curacy and benefice by the name or style of the perpetual curacy of Llechylched - cum-Ceirchiog of which parish and benefice the said church of Llechylched shall be the parish church and the same shall be and remain under the same ecclesiastical jurisdiction as that under which the said rectory of Llanbeulan now is.

"That the incumbent of Llechylched-cum-Ceirchiog shall have exclusive cure of souls within the limits of the said proposed separate parish and

benefice.

"That baptisms churchings marriages and burials shall be performed celebrated and take place in the parish church of the said proposed separate parish and benefice and in the churchyard thereto belonging and that the fees for all such and other ecclesiastical offices arising from or in respect of the said proposed separate parish and benefice and usually payable to the incumbent of a benefice shall belong and be paid to the incumbent of Llechylched-cum-Ceirchiog.

"That the whole of the rectorial tithe rentcharge arising or payable in respect of lands within the said proposed separate parish and benefice now belonging to the said rectory of Llanbeulan and amounting together as mentioned in the above written representation to the annual sum of three hundred and one pounds together with the glebe and glebe rents situate and arising within the said proposed separate parish and benefice and the moneys received by the sale of a portion of the said glebe the particulars of which are also mentioned in the above written representation be annexed and belong to and form part of the endowment of the said proposed separate parish and benefice of Llechylched-cum-Ceirchiog.

"That the inhabitants of the said proposed separate parish and benefice shall be exonerated from all liability to repair any churches situate elsewhere than within the limits of the said proposed separate parish and benefice but shall be liable subject to the provisions of 'The Compulsory Church Rate Abolition Act 1868' to repair the said parish church of the said proposed

separate parish and benefice.

"That the inhabitants of the said proposed separate parish and benefice shall be entitled to resort to and attend the said parish church thereof and to be accommodated with sittings therein but shall not henceforth be entitled to any accommodation in the churches of Llanbeulan and Llanfaelog.

"That nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect the right of patronage to the said benefice of Llanbeulan but that the same shall remain continue and be as it now is and that the patronage of the said proposed separate parish and benefice of Llechylched-cum-Ceirchiog shall belong to and be vested in the Right Reverend James Colquioun Lord Bishop of Bangor and his successors for ever.

"That nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect the revenues and endowments of the said rectory of Llanbeulan with the township or chapelry of Llanfaelog except as

hereinbefore-mentioned.
