WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of "The Ecclesiastical Commission Act 1868" duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a scheme, bearing date the twenty-first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England in pursuance of the 'Ecclesiastical Commission Act 1868' section three have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme for effecting an exchange of a part of the property of the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Norwich

for certain property belonging to us.

"Whereas the lands and hereditaments particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed and marked A are a part of the property of the Dean and Chapter of Norwich being a part of the property which was transferred to them by an Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the seventeenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine which Order was published in the London Gazette on the nineteenth day of the same month and the said Dean and Chapter have agreed that the said lands and hereditaments shall be transferred to us in consideration of the transfer to them of certain lands tithes and hereditaments now belonging to us being the lands tithes and hereditaments particularly described and set forth in the schedule hereunto annexed and marked B and of the money payments hereinafter mentioned.

"And whereas the lands comprised in the said with the provisions of the saischedule hereunto annexed and marked B are not any other Act of Parliament.

now in our possession but are held under us by certain beneficial leases granted for terms of years at small reserved rents which leases will expire on the eighth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine and it has been agreed between us and the said Dean and Chapter that in part consideration of the transfer to us of the lands and hereditaments comprised in the said schedule marked A there shall be paid by us to them the annual sum hereinafter mentioned during the subsistence of the beneficial leases aforesaid.

"And whereas the terms of such transfer are in our opinion fair and reasonable.

"Now therefore we humbly recommend and propose with the consent of the said Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Norwich and with the consent of the Honourable and Right Reverend John Thomas, Bishop of Norwich as Visitor of the said Dean and Chapter certified by their having hereunto affixed their respective corporate seals that upon and from the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme and without any further conveyance or act in the law the lands and hereditaments described in the schedule hereunto annexed marked A with their appurtenances shall subject always to the liabilities and charges to which the said lands and hereditaments or the said Dean and Chapter in respect thereof are now specifically liable be transferred to us in the manner contemplated in the said Act and that we shall be entitled to the rents profits and proceeds thereof as from the twenty-ninth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six and that in consideration for such transfer to us as aforesaid the lands tithes and hereditaments particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed and marked B. with their appurtenances together with the benefit of so much of the perpetual land tax charged thereon as has been redeemed shall subject always to the liabilities and charges to which the said lands tithes and hereditaments are now specifically liable be transferred to the said Dean and Chapter in the manner contemplated by the said Act and that the said Dean and Chapter shall become entitled to the rents profits and proceeds thereof as from the said twenty-ninth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-

"And we further recommend and propose that in further consideration for such transfer to us as aforesaid we shall pay to the said Dean and Chapter during the period intervening between the said twenty-ninth day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six and the said eighth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, the sum of two hundred and twenty-eight pounds per annum.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid in conformity with the provisions of the said recited Act or of any other Act of Parliament.
