“(3.) The several other Authorities for the time being whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being wholly situated within the said Audit District.

“(4.) Such of the said other Authorities whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be so audited, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being partly situated within the said Audit District, as We may by Order under Seal hereafter prescribe.”

And whereas by certain Orders dated the 2nd day of December, 1879, the 15th day of January, 1880, and the 2nd day of August, 1882, We ordered and prescribed that it should be the duty of the said Hugh Lloyd-Roberts to audit the Accounts of the following Authorities and their Officers, namely, the Board of Management of the North Surrey District School, the School Board for London, and the Board of Management of the Metropolitan Asylum District;

And whereas it is expedient that the said City of London Union should be included in the said Audit District:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We hereby Order and Prescribe that, until We shall otherwise prescribe, the said Metropolitan Audit District shall, in addition to the area defined by the first above-cited Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the said City of London Union; and that the provisions of Articles 2, 3, and 5 of that Order shall be applicable as if the said Union had been originally included in the said Audit District.

**TENDERS FOR LOANS ON TREASURY BILLS.**
