

The Lord Lieutenant presented the following gentlemen to The Queen :—J. Hartopp Nash, Esq., The Chairman of the Slough Local Board; Springall Thompson, Esq., The Vice-Chairman of the Slough Reception Committee; Rev. H. Woollett, Esq., the Honorary Secretary and Treasurer.

The Viscount Curzon, Member of Parliament for the Southern or Wycombe Division of Bucks, was present.

The following Addresses were handed to Her Majesty :—

The Queen returned gracious replies to the Addresses.

The Queen accepted a Bouquet from Miss Isabel Young, daughter of The Rector of Upton-cum-Chalvey.

A guard of honour of 100 rank and file of the 1st Bucks Volunteers, under the command of Major H. Hearn, was mounted in the Slough Station Yard.

The children of the British Orphan Asylum, of the Town of Slough, and of the neighbouring Parishes of Beaconsfield, Burnham, Datchet, Farnham Royal, Hedgerley, Langley, Taplow, and Upton-cum-Chalvey, sang "God Save The Queen" as Her Majesty's carriage approached the stands in the station yard.

On leaving Slough Station Her Majesty's Route was as follows :—

Mackenzie Street Slough, a portion of High-Street Slough, Windsor Road, Eton College, High Street Eton, Windsor Bridge, Thames Street Windsor, High Street and Park Street Windsor, through the Long Walk gates to Windsor Castle.

The Queen was escorted by a Captain's Escort with a Standard of the Royal Horse Guards (Blue), under the command of Major The Lord Kilmarnock.
