(SWINE-FEVER.)

AT the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 1st day of August, 1888.

By Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1886, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The following Place (namely),—all that pen in the market or sale-yard of Mr. John Brown, situate at St. Neots, in the county of Huntingdon, in which certain pigs the property of Mr. Joseph Bates of Pertenhall, were lately found to be affected with swine-fever, together with all adjoining pens within a distance of eight yards therefrom,—which was declared by Order of Council dated the eighth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, to be a Place infected with swine-fever, is hereby declared to be free from swine-fever, and that Place shall, as from the commencement of this Order, cease to be a Place infected with swine-fever.

2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the second day of August, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight.

THE ANIMALS (AMENDMENT) ORDER OF 1888, No. 3.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1886, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Revocation of The Animals (Amendment) Order of 1888.

1. The Animals (Amendment) Order of 1888

is hereby from and after the commencement of this Order revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or made unlawful anything done under the said Order hereby revoked, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the said Order hereby revoked, before the commencement of this Order.

Amendment of Article 130 of The Animals Order of 1886.

2. The following provisions of this Article shall be read in the place of Article 130 of The Animals Order of 1886, and this Article shall be deemed to be Article 130 of that Order (namely):

Conditions of Landing.

130.—(1.) The landing of foreign animals at a Foreign Animals Wharf under the provisions of this Chapter is subject to the following conditions:

First. That the vessel in which they are imported has not, within twenty-eight days before taking them on board, had on board any animal exported or carried coastwise from a port or place in any of the countries mentioned in Part I of the Fourth Schedule, or from a port or place in Malta, or in Belgium, or from any port or place from which the landing of animals is for the time being prohibited, or any cattle exported or carried coastwise from a port or place in the German Empire or any cattle, sheep, or goats being or having been on board a vessel at the same time with cattle so brought.

Second. That the vessel has not within twenty-one days before taking them on board or at any time since taking on board the animals imported, entered any port or place in any of the countries mentioned in Part I of the Fourth Schedule, or any port or place in Malta, or in Belgium, or any port or place from which the landing of animals is for the time being prohibited.

Third. That the animals imported have not, while on board the vessel, been in contact with any animal exported or carried coastwise from any port or place in any of the countries mentioned in Part I of the Fourth Schedule, or from any port or place in Malta, or in Belgium, or from any port or place from which the landing of animals is for the time being prohibited, or any cattle exported or carried coastwise from a port or place in the German Empire, or any cattle, sheep, or
