SCHEDULE.

An Area in the county of Essex comprised within a line commencing at the south-west boundary of the parish of Waltham on the high-road leading from Chingford to Waltham Abbey, thence starting in an easterly direction along the road by Yardley House to the Woodman Inn, thence by the western boundary of Epping Forest through High Beech to Honey-lane Plain, thence by Woodgreen Potteries along the northern boundary of Serjeant's Green, thence by the line to Copthall Green and Cleveringbury to Aimes Green and by Puck-lane and the Nasing-road to Fisher's Green, thence along the northern boundary of Hook's Marsh to the western boundary of the county, thence along the boundary of the county of Essex and Middlesex to the southern boundary of the parish of Waltham, and thence along the southern boundary of the said parish to the point in the road leading from Chingford to Waltham aforesaid; the roads named being within the limits of the Area.

SCHEDULE.

An Area in the county of Hertford comprised within a line commencing on the eastern boundary of the parish of Cheshunt where a certain watercourse from Flamstead End flows into the river Lea, thence westward along the line of watercourse to the New River, thence south along the course of the New River to the southern boundary of the county of Hertford against Enfield, thence east along the southern boundary of the county to the boundary against Essex, thence to the north along the eastern boundary of the county of Hertford to the watercourse on the eastern boundary aforesaid.
