

No. 3, otherwise Southgate Ward, shall comprise so much of the area of the borough of Bury Saint Edmunds as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the borough boundary with the River Lark near the Great Eastern Railway, thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of the borough to Horringer-road, thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of Horringer-road to the centre of Stamford Bridge, thence to and along the centre of Out Westgate to a point opposite to the centre of St. Andrew's-street, thence to and along the centre of Westgate-road to a point opposite to the centre of Crown-street, thence to and along the centre of Crown-street to the Norman Tower, thence to and along the centre of the street leading to Angel-hill, thence along the eastern side of Angel-hill to the boundary of No. 2 Ward, thence in an easterly direction along the boundary of No. 2 Ward to Eastgate Bridge, and thence along the said boundary in a southerly direction to the point of commencement aforesaid.

And I do hereby determine that the said Ward No. 4, otherwise Westgate Ward, shall comprise so much of the area of the borough of Bury Saint Edmunds as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the Cemetery-road with St. Andrew's-street, thence to and along the centre of the Cemetery-road to a point opposite to the centre of Chalk-lane, thence in a northerly direction to and along the centre of Chalk-lane to the boundary of No. 1 Ward, thence in a westerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of the borough, thence in a southerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of No. 3 Ward, thence in a north-easterly direction along the said boundary to a point opposite to the centre of St. Andrew's-street, thence to and along the centre of St. Andrew's-street South, to the point of commencement aforesaid.

And I do hereby determine that the said Ward No. 5, otherwise Risbygate Ward, shall comprise so much of the area of the borough of Bury Saint Edmunds as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of St. Andrew's-street with the Cemetery-road aforesaid, thence in a westerly and northerly direction along the boundary of No. 4 Ward to the boundary of No. 1 Ward, thence in an easterly, northerly, easterly and southerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of No. 2 Ward, thence in a southerly direction along the said boundary to a point opposite to the centre of Brentgovel-street, thence in a westerly direction along the centre of Brentgovel-street to a point opposite to the centre of St. Andrew's-street North, thence in a southerly direction to and along the centre of St. Andrew's-street North to the point of commencement aforesaid.

And I do hereby determine that the said Ward No. 6, otherwise Abbeygate Ward, shall comprise so much of the area of the borough of Bury Saint Edmunds as is contained within a line commencing from the said point of intersection of St. Andrew's-street South with the Cemetery-road, thence in a southerly direction along the eastern boundary of No. 4 Ward to the boundary of No. 3 Ward, thence in an easterly and northerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of No. 2 Ward, thence in a northerly and westerly direction along the boundary of No. 2 Ward to the boundary of No. 5 Ward, thence in a westerly and southerly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.
