GENERAL ORDER of the Local Government Board. Workhouse and Infirmary Regulations: Altering: Appointment of Nurses:—

West Derby Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the West Derby Union, in the County of Lancaster and the County Boroughs of Bootle cum Linacre and Liverpool;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by a General Order dated the 24th day of July, 1847, addressed to the Guardians of the Poor of the said West Derby Union (among others), the Poor Law Commissioners made certain Regulations for the government of the Workhouse of that Union;

And whereas by Article 153 of the said Order provision was made for the appointment by the said Guardians of persons to hold certain offices in the said Workhouse, including the office of Nurse, and by Articles 155 and 172 of such Order
