ORDER OF SECRETARY OF STATE, No. 3. (b).
EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875 (38 Vict., cap. 17).

WHEREAS by Part I (section 33) of the Explosives Act, 1875, General Rules are set forth to be observed with respect to the packing of Gunpowder for conveyance:

And whereas by the said section 33 it is enacted that the Secretary of State may from time to time make, and when made, repeal, alter, and add to, rules for the purpose of rescinding, alter-

ing, or adding to the general rules contained in this section, and the rules so made by the Secretary of State shall have the same effect as if they were enacted in this section:

Now, therefore, in the exercise of the powers aforesaid, I, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, hereby order as follows:—

Notwithstanding anything in the General Rules in the said section 33 contained, it shall be lawful to enclose the outer package of any double pack-
