## (SWINE-FEVER.)

By the Board of Agriculture.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1886, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :

1. The following Place (namely),—the cowshed, field, and premises adjoining situate at Zeals, in the parish of Mere, in the county of Wilts, in the occupation of Jane Turner, together with the whole of the premises situate in the parish of Bourton, in the county of Dorset, also in the occupation of the said Jane Turner,—which was declared by Order of the Board dated the twelfth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety, to be a Place infected with swine-fever, is hereby declared to be free from swine-fever, and that Place shall, as from the

commencement of this Order, cease to be a Place infected with swine-fever.

2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and ninety.
