ART. 5. The medical inspector should remain on board the gunboat "La Popa" for all purposes connected with the regulation of quarantines.

ART. 6. The Prefects of the Provinces shall at once proceed to dictate the necessary measures concerning the police, cleanliness and hygiene of the districts under their jurisdiction.

ART. 7. The captain of the gunboat "La Popa" and the captains of the different ports are especially charged to carry out the provisions of the present Decree.

Let this be communicated, published, and reported to the Home Office.
