THE Board of Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, from Her Majesty's Representative at Washington, the following copy of a Proclamation by the Governor of Louisiana:

PROCLAMATION by the Governor withdrawing Quarantine Restrictions.

Executive Department, State of Louisiana.

WHEREAS, at a Meeting of the Board of

Health of the State of Louisiana, held in the city of New Orleans, on the 23rd day of October, 1890, a resolution was adopted requesting the Executive to issue a Proclamation withdrawing all restrictions against vessels arriving at the port of New Orleans on and after the 1st day of November, 1890.

Therefore I, Francis T. Nicholls, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority in me vested by law and in compliance with said resolution, do hereby revoke, annul, and withdraw the annual proclamation of quarantine, issued by me on the 18th day of April, 1890, said revocation to go into effect from and after the 1st day of November, 1890.

Given under my signature and the seal of the State of Louisiana, at the city of Baton Rouge, the 25th day of October, A.D. 1890.
