And whereas notice of the said representation, and of the time when I should take the same into consideration, has been duly given to the Clerk to the Justices acting in the Wells Petty Sessional Division of the county of Somerset, within which Division the Fairs in question are held, and otherwise published in pursuance of "The Fairs Act, 1873 :

And whereas on such representation and consideration it appears to me that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the time for the holding of the said Fairs should be altered as proposed:
