

DISRAELI ROAD, Putney.	Putney, and extending Westwards; horses' heads Eastwards. Three Carriages. Commencing at the Gully, near High Street, Putney, and extending Eastwards along the North side of Disraeli Road, a sufficient distance for three Hackney Carriages.
UPPER RICHMOND ROAD, Putney.	Five Carriages. Commencing at the junction of Upper Richmond Road and Putney Hill, and extending Eastwards along the centre of Upper Richmond Road a sufficient distance for five Hackney Carriages; horses' heads towards the West.
OXFORD ROAD, Putney.	Four Carriages. Commencing at the North end of bridge that crosses the L. & S.W. Railway in Oxford Road, Putney, and extending Southwards on West side thereof a sufficient distance for four Hackney Carriages; horses' heads Northwards.
KENSINGTON ROAD, Knightsbridge Barracks. (East of main entrance.)	Six Carriages. At Kensington Road, to commence fifteen feet West of the Eastern boundary of Knightsbridge Barracks, along the kerb, extending West as far as necessary.
KENSINGTON ROAD, Knightsbridge Barracks. (West of main entrance.)	Six Carriages. At Kensington Road, to commence fifteen feet West of main gate of Knightsbridge Barracks, extending West by kerb as far as necessary.
KENSINGTON ROAD, Knightsbridge Barracks. (By Officers' Quarters.)	Twenty Carriages. At Kensington Road, to commence at lamp-post, thirty feet West of entrance to the Officers' Quarters, Knightsbridge Barracks, and extend along the side of the footway Westward as far as necessary.
THE AVENUE, Bedford Park, Chiswick.	Six Carriages. In the Avenue, Bedford Park, Chiswick, to commence on the West side of the said Avenue, North of the Railway Bridge opposite the "up line" entrance, and booking office of the Turnham Green Station; and with horses' heads Southwards, to stand alongside the railings of the Green as far as may be necessary for six Hackney Carriages to stand.
UXBRIDGE ROAD, Ossington Street.	Nine Carriages. In the centre of Uxbridge Road, by Ossington Street, Paddington; commencing opposite the corner of Ossington Street, and to extend one hundred and fifty feet Eastward; horses' heads to the West.
TOTTENHAM COURT ROAD, Warren Street.	Six Carriages. Commencing in centre of road at the Urinal, North end of Tottenham Court Road, and Warren Street, extending Southwards as far as necessary, keeping clear of Warren Street and Tottenham Place; horses' heads Southwards, except two at North end of rank to face Northwards.
TOTTENHAM COURT ROAD, Midford Place.	Three Carriages. Commencing in centre of Tottenham Court Road from London Street, extending Northwards as far as necessary; horses' heads Northwards.
SHEPHERD'S BUSH ROAD, West Kensington Park.	Three Carriages. In Shepherd's Bush Road (centre of), West Kensington Park, to the North of "Sugg's Patent Lamp," opposite the "Richmond Hotel"; with horses' heads facing Northwards as far as may be necessary for three Hackney Carriages to stand.
CLAPHAM COMMON, Cavendish Road.	Three Carriages. At Clapham Common, commencing North side of Carriage Drive, South side of Clapham Common, opposite Cavendish Road, extending Westward as far as necessary for three Hackney Carriages; horses' heads towards Cavendish Road.
THEOBALD'S ROAD, Southampton Row.	Three Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Theobald's Road, commencing East of the Refuge at Southampton Row; horses' heads towards the West.
HIGH HOLBORN, Dean Street.	Fourteen Carriages. In the centre of the roadway of Holborn from Red Lion Yard to New Turnstile; horses' heads towards the West.
AVENUE ROAD and FINCHLEY NEW ROAD, Swiss Cottage.	Thirteen Carriages. Two of the number to stand in the Finchley New Road, under the dead wall of the Swiss Cottage Railway Station; the horses' heads towards the "Swiss Cottage" Public-House; the rank continuing at the North-West side of Avenue Road, at junction with Finchley Road (clear of the Dairy), and extending in a South-Easterly direction along under stable
