Turin, December 9.

"HE French have put four Battalions into sufa, and about 600 Horse into Pignerol over and above the ordinary Garison, and the seft of their Troops, as we understand, are goe into Winter Quarters in Saccy and Dauphine. The Governor of Milan intends to return hither to pay the Spanish Auxi-lay Troops, which will be confiderably Reinfored against the Spring, besides the Succors our Duke tipects from other Princes his Allies. The Vaudois his lately taken 60 Wagons laden with Wine, dehad to Pignero!, killing 14 of the French Soldiers that conducted the Convoy. The German Troops is his Highness's Service have part of them their Omiters at Vigone, Piofasco, and other places on the side of Pignerol; and the rest at Ivrent, Trano, Vicelli, Rivoli, and in this City.

Zwick, December 17. We have an account con Piedmont, that part of the Garison of Pigne-

General Caprara remains in the Empire to command the faid Forces during the Winter. Yesterday arrived here an Express from Prince Louis with Letters of the 12th instant, which give an account, that he was then encamped near a place called Erd:s; that he had received advice, that a Body of 10 or 12000 Turks and Tartars, who had been some time about Debrezen, understanding that Prince Louis was come to Zaimar, and that he designed to march against them, they were again retired into Transsivania, which had obliged him to return towards Clausen-burg. The Emperor is sending an Envoy to Musbusiness is to endeavour to perswade the Czar to bring his Army into the Field very early in the Spring in order to fall into the Crimee, and thereby divert the Fartars from fending any Affistances to the Turks. The Elector of Bavaria has, fince his arrival here, affifted at several Councils of War; and we are told, that his Electoral Highness will part from hence before the end of this Month, and take his Journey to the Hague to meet His Majesty of Great. Britain.
