From and after the date when this Warrant comes into operation, all Parcels transmitted from Natal to any British Colony or Possessian or any Foreign Country with which a Parcel Post is established via the United Kingdom shall be subject to the rates of postage respectively specified in Part II of the Schedule to and to the provi-
