THE following Statutes, passed on the twenty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, by the Governing Body of Trinity College or Hall, in the University of Cambridge, and sealed on the thirtieth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions contained in the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1877:—

STATUTES to add to alter and amend the Statutes framed by the Commissioners appointed under the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1877, 40 and 41 Victoria chapter 88 in relation to the College or Hall of the Holy Trinity in the University of Cambridge duly made at a General Meeting of the Governing Body of the said College or Hall specially summoned for this purpose held on the 21st day of December 1891 and passed at such Meeting by the unanimous vote of all persons present and voting, there being then present the Master and ten Fellows and now submitted for the approval of Her Majesty the Queen in Council.

We the Master or Keeper and Fellows and Scholars of the said College or Hall do hereby in exercise of the powers given to us by the 54th Section of the said Act add to alter and amend the Statutes framed by the said Commissioners in relation to our said College or Hall in the following manner:—
