

Exemption from Muzzling of Dogs with Collars &c. in certain Districts.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order, the Rabies (Muzzling of Dogs) Order of 1889 shall in its application to the Districts and part of District of Local Authorities mentioned in the Schedule to this Order be read and have effect as if the following paragraph were inserted at the end of Article 6 (*Muzzling of Dogs*) of the said Order of 1889, namely—

(c.) Dogs which have on a collar with the name and address of the owner of the dog legibly engraved on such collar ; and the requirements as to muzzling contained in the said Article 6 shall not apply to such dogs as aforesaid in those Districts or part of District.

Revocation of Order.

2. The Rabies (Muzzling of Dogs) Order of 1889, Amendment No. 7, is hereby revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful anything done under that Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against or any penalty incurred under that Order.

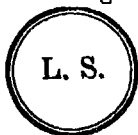
Short Title.

Commencement.

4. This Order shall commence and take effect from and immediately after the sixteenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two.

THE RABIES (MUZZLING OF DOGS) ORDER OF 1889, AMENDMENT No. 12.

By the Board of Agriculture.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1890, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Exemption from Muzzling of Dogs with Collars &c. in certain Districts.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order, the Rabies (Muzzling of Dogs) Order of 1889 shall in its application to the Districts of Local Authorities mentioned in the First Schedule to this Order be read and have effect as if the following paragraph were inserted at the end of Article 6 (*Muzzling of Dogs*) of the said Order of 1889, namely—

(c.) Dogs which have on a collar with the name and address of the owner of the dog legibly engraved on such collar ; and the requirements as to muzzling contained in the said Article 6 shall not apply to such dogs as aforesaid in those Districts.

Revocation of Orders.

2. The Orders mentioned in the Second Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the Orders hereby revoked, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against or any penalty incurred under the Orders hereby revoked.

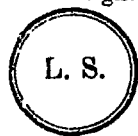
Short Title.
