contract, agreement, or arrangement made or to

be made prior to the passing of the Bill.
24. To confer upon the Company all other rights, powers, privileges, and authorities necessary or convenient for carrying into complete and full effect the objects and purposes of the Bill, to vary and extinguish all rights and privileges which would in any way impede or interfere with those objects and purposes, and to confer other rights and privileges.
