BALTIC ENTRANCE.—THE KATTEGAT—SWEDISH COAST.

Light-Vessel with Fog Signal near Fladen Bank.

THE Swedish Government has given notice, that during the autumn of 1892, a light-vessel would be placed near Fladen Bank, about one mile E. by S. from the depth of $4\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms on its eastern side:—

Fladen Bank Light is a group flashing red light, showing two flashes in quick succession every half minute. The illuminating apparatus is catoptric.

Approximate position on Admiralty Charts, lat. $57^{\circ} 10' N.$, long. $11^{\circ} 50' E.$

Also, that a fog siren will be established on board Fladen Bank Light-vessel.

Further particulars concerning this light-vessel will be published in due course.
