## Office of the Secretary for Scotland, Whitehall, December 30, 1892.

THE Secretary for Scotland has been pleased, by Warrant under his hand and Seal, to appoint Mr. David Forsyth, Solicitor, Elgin, to be Sheriff-Clerk of the County of Elgin, in the room of Mr. James Jameson, deceased.

## (H. 80.) Board of Trade (Harbour Department), London, January 5, 1893.

THE Board of Trade have received, through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, a copy of the following Telegrams, dated 4th January, 1893, from Her Majesty's Representative at Constantinople:—

"Quarantine of five days imposed on arrivals from Hamburg and from the mouths of the Elbe with disinfection at a lazaret: this quarantine to commence from departures on and after the 29th ultimo."

"Quarantine on arrivals from Austro-Hungarian ports in the Adriatic and Roumanian and Bulgarian ports with passengers on board reduced to twentyfour hours observation, with disinfection: without passengers on board to a medical visit only."

"Quarantine on arrivals from Odessa with passengers on board reduced to forty-eight hours' observation, with disinfection of clothing, &c.: the arrivals without passengers will be subjected to a medical visit only."

A sanitary circular, dated "Constantinople, 21st December, 1892," also states that the twenty-four hours' observation imposed on arrivals from Northern France (Belgian frontier to Cherbourg, exclusive) is replaced by a strict medical visit, for departures since the 20th December, 1892.
