

## SOLDIERS' BALANCES UNCLAIMED.

IN pursuance of "The Regimental Debts Act, 1863," notice is hereby given, that Her Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for the War Department has available, for distribution amongst the Next of Kin or others entitled, the sum of money set opposite to the name of each of the deceased soldiers named in the list which is published with this notice in the London Gazette, and the "Army List," and is also to be seen at the Regimental Districts for the Pension Service throughout the United Kingdom.

Applications from persons supposing themselves entitled as Next of Kin should be addressed by letter to "The Under Secretary of State, War Office, London, S.W.," and marked outside "Soldier's Effects."
