In the High Court of Justice.—Chancery Division.
Mr. Justice Chitty.

In the Matter of I. W. Parmenter and Co. Limited and Reduced; and in the Matter of the Companies Act, 1867; and in the Matter of the Companies Act, 1877.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Order of the High Court of Justice, Chancery Division, dated Tuesday, the 13th day of December, 1892, confirming the reduction of the capital of the abovenamed Company from £10,000 to £8,000, and the Minute approved by the Court showing, with respect to the capital of the Company as altered, the several particulars required by the

above Statutes, were registered by the Registrar of Joint Stock Companies on the 20th day of January, 1893. And further take notice, that the said Minute is in the words and figures following:—
