the centre of Newport-road, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centre of Newport-road to a point opposite to the centre of Harting-ton-road, thence in a south-easterly direction to and along the centre of Hartington-road to the centre of Borough road West, thence in an easterly direction to and along the centre of Borough-road West to the centre of Linthorpe-road, thence in a northerly direction along the centre of Linthorpe-road to the boundary of Ward No. 3, thence in a northerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of Ward No. 2, and thence along the boundary of Ward No. 2 in a northerly direction to the point of commence-ment aforesaid.
