

that the said schedule to this scheme annexed shall as to the first column thereof be (in so far as the same legally can or may be) as from the day aforesaid substituted for the hereinbefore mentioned statutory schedule of rural deaneries within the said diocese of Manchester as aforesaid and for the schedules referred to in the said Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the thirteenth day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven as aforesaid.

“ And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other matter or thing with respect to the matters aforesaid or any of them under or by virtue of the said Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.
