And whereas it has been made to appear to Her Majesty that the said new Bye-laws and Rates

of Pilotage are reasonable and proper:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, by virtue of the power vested in Her by the said Merchant Shipping Act, 1854, and by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, is pleased to approve of, and signify Her consent to the said new Byelaws and Rates of Pilotage as set forth in the Schedule hereto annexed.

SCHEDULE.

BYE-LAWS and Rates of Pilotage made and established by the Corporation of the Guild or Brotherhood of Masters and Pilots Seamen of the Trinity House in Kingston-upon-Hull for the better regulation of the Pilots and Pilotage of the ports of Kingston-upon-Hull and Great Grimsby.

1. In lieu of the rates and other remuneration heretofore received by the Humber Pilots for the piloting or conducting of ships and vessels the undermentioned rates and other remuneration shall in future be demanded and received by them.

2. The undermentioned rates and other remuneration shall be subject to quinquennial revision the first revision to be made at the end of five years from the date of the Order in Council confirming these Bye-laws; and until such revision shall be established and confirmed by Order in Council the undermentioned rates (or the revised rates or remuneration as the case may be) shall continue in force.
