Dartmouth Harbour.

(Raising of Additional Capital; Application of Funds; Other Powers; Steam and other Signalling; Amendment or Repeal of Acts or Orders.)

**N**OTICE is hereby given that an application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade, on or before the 23rd day of December next, by the Dartmouth Harbour Commissioners (here under referred to as "the Commissioners") for a Provisional Order, pursuant to the General Pier and Harbour Act, 1861, and the General Pier and Harbour Act, 1861, Amendment Act, for the following purposes, or some of them, that is to say:—

To authorise the Commissioners to create and issue mortgages, bonds, or other securities, in payment or satisfaction of the existing mortgages, bonds, or debts, and interest thereon or any part thereof, and to borrow further moneys on mortgage of the whole or any part of their property, tolls and undertaking, or on bonds, or otherwise, and to apply the same in payment or satisfaction of the existing mortgages, bonds, or debts, and interest, or any part thereof, and for the general purposes of the Undertaking.

To provide that the mortgages or bonds to be issued under the powers of the Order may be entitled to priorities or preferences, *inter se*, or may be issued in one or more series, having distinct rights and securities, and to provide for the redemption of one or more series of bonds in priority to others.

To prohibit the use of sirens, steam or other signals on vessels within the limits of the harbour, and to impose penalties and restrictions with reference thereto.

To confer upon the Commissioners all such rights, powers, privileges, and authorities as are, or may become, necessary for carrying the powers of the Order into complete and full effect, to vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would, in any manner, impede or interfere with the objects and purposes of the Order, and to confer other rights and privileges.

To alter, amend, extend, enlarge, or to repeal, so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the Order, the provisions or some of the provisions of the several local and personal Acts following, or some of them, that is to say:—

The Pier and Harbour Orders Confirmation Act, 1863, and the Pier and Harbour Order Confirmation Act, 1870 (No. 1), so far as the same affect or relate to the Dartmouth Harbour Order, 1863, and the Dartmouth Harbour Order, 1870, the Dartmouth Harbour Improvement Act, 1882, and such other Orders or Acts of Parliament relating to, or affecting the harbour, or which may relate to or be affected by the objects of the Order.

A copy of this Notice, as published in the London Gazette, will, on or before the 30th day of November instant, be deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the county of Devon, at his office at Exeter, in such
