In the Chancery of the County Palatine of Lancaster.—Manchester District.

Companies (Winding-up).

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 to 1890; and in the Matter of the Lansdowne Cotton Spinning Company Limited; and in the Matter of the Court of Chancery of Lancaster Acts, 1850 to 1890.

BY an Order made by the Vice-Chancellor in the above matter, dated the 24th day of October, 1893, on the petition of the Manchester and County Bank Limited, of 55, King-street, in the city of Manchester, in the county of Lancaster, it was ordered that the voluntary winding up of the abovementioned Lansdowne Cotton Spinning Company Limited be continued, but subject

to the supervision of this Court, and any of the proceedings under the said voluntary winding up might be adopted as the Court or Vice-Chancellor should think fit. And the creditors, contributories, and Liquidators of the said Company, and all other persons interested, were to be at liberty to apply to the Vice-Chancellor, at the chambers of the Registrar, as there might be occasion. And it was ordered that the costs of the petitioners, and of the said Company, and the Liquidators thereof, and the said creditors supporting the petition of that application, be taxed by the Registrar, and paid out of the assets of the said Company, and on such taxation one set of costs were to be allowed to the said creditors supporting the said petition; and it was ordered
