

of the said parish prepared in the month of April one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, that the said parish contains sixteen thousand four hundred and twenty-eight rated householders, and that the rateable annual value of property in the said parish is four hundred and seventy-three thousand two hundred and fifty-two pounds.

Now the London County Council having considered the said application, and having taken into consideration the number of persons rated to the relief of the poor in each ward of the said parish and the aggregate amount of the sums at which all such persons are rated, and all the circumstances connected with such application, doth hereby order that the wards of the said parish of Fulham be re-arranged in manner

following, that is to say, that the said parish be divided into eight instead of three wards, and that the eight wards be distinguished by the names mentioned in the first column of the under-mentioned Schedule, that the extent, limits, and boundary lines of such wards shall be those described in the second column of the said Schedule; and that the number of vestrymen to be elected for each of the said wards shall be the number mentioned in the third column of the said Schedule.

And the London County Council doth further order that this Order shall come into force for the purpose of the first election of vestrymen under the Local Government Act, 1894, and such election shall be subject to the provisions of the said Act.
