THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the

Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1893, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

The Order of the Board dated the thirtieth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, prohibiting the sale or exposure for sale of any cattle sheep or swine in or at the Cattle Market at Cirencester in the county of Gloucester, shall be read and have effect as if the thirty-first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four were substituted for the thirty-first day of July, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four in Article 3 of that Order, as the date from and immediately after which that Order shall take effect.

In witness whereof the Board of Agriculture have hereunto set their Official Seal this fourth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.
