amount of the sums at which all such persons are rated, and all the circumstances connected with such application, doth hereby order that the wards of the said parish of Paddington be rearranged in manner following, that is to say, that the said parish be divided into six instead of four wards, and that the six wards be distinguished by the names mentioned in the first column of the undermentioned Schedule, that the extent, limits, and boundary lines of such wards shall be those described in the second column of the said Schedule;

and that the number of vestrymen to be elected for each of the said wards shall be the number mentioned in the third column of the said Schedule.

And the London County Council doth further order that this Order shall come into force for the purpose of the first election of vestrymen under the Local Government Act, 1894, and such election shall be subject to the provisions of the said Act.
