

the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the western boundary of Ward No. 5 and the boundary of the county borough at low-water mark thence in a northerly direction along the said western boundary of Ward No. 5, to the centre of Clifton Hill, thence in a north-westerly direction along the centre of Clifton Hill to the western boundary of the county borough, thence in a south-westerly and easterly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

“And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 7 otherwise ‘Montpelier Ward’ shall comprise so much of the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from a point in the boundary of Ward No. 5 opposite to the centre of Buckingham-road, thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of Buckingham-road to a point opposite to the centre of Gloucester-road, thence in an easterly direction to and along the centre of Gloucester-road to the centre of Queen’s-road, thence in a northerly direction along the centre of Queen’s-road to a point on the railway arch immediately above the centre of Trafalgar-street, thence by a vertical line to the centre of Trafalgar-street, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Trafalgar-street to Station-street, thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of the London, Brighton and South Coast Railway Goods Station, on the western side of Station-street, to Cheapside, thence across Cheapside to the boundary of the said goods yard of the said railway, thence in an easterly direction along the said boundary to Queen-street, thence in a northerly direction along the said boundary at the western side of Queen-street to Peel-street, thence in a northerly direction along the said boundary to the centre of New England-road, thence in a westerly direction along the centre of New England-road to Old Shoreham-road, thence in a westerly direction to and along the centre of Old Shoreham-road to the boundary of the county borough at Prestonville-road, thence in a south-westerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of Ward No. 6, thence in a south-easterly direction along the northern boundary of Ward No. 6 to the boundary of Ward No. 5, thence in a south-easterly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

“And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 8 otherwise Saint Nicholas Ward shall comprise so much of the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from a point in the western boundary of Ward No. 3 opposite to the centre of Church-street, thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 4 to the centre of Queen’s-road, thence in a southerly direction along the western boundary of Ward No. 4 to the boundary of Ward No. 5, thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 5 to the boundary of Ward No. 7 in Buckingham-road, thence in a north-easterly, easterly, northerly, and easterly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 7 to a point opposite to the boundary wall of the London Brighton and South Coast Railway Goods Yard aforesaid, thence in an easterly direction along the centre of Trafalgar-street to the centre of York-place, thence in a south-easterly direction by a line measuring two hundred and thirty-six and a half linear feet to a point at the base of the south-western front of the drinking fountain, thence in a south-easterly direction by a line measuring one hundred and sixty-three linear

feet to a point in the centre of the Grand Parade opposite to the centre of Richmond-street, thence in a southerly direction along the centre of the Grand Parade to the boundary of Ward No. 3, thence in a southerly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

“And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 9 otherwise St. John’s Ward shall comprise so much of the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the boundary of Ward No. 3 and the boundary of Ward No. 8 opposite to the centre of Carlton-hill, thence in a northerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 8 to a point opposite to the centre of Richmond-street, thence in a northerly direction to and along the centre of Richmond-place to Waterloo-place, thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of Waterloo-place to Richmond-terrace, thence in a north-easterly direction to and along the centre of Richmond-terrace to a point opposite to the centre of South-over-street, thence in a south-easterly direction to and along the centre of Southover-street to the boundary of Ward No. 2, thence in a south-westerly direction along the said boundary to the boundary of Ward No. 3, thence in a south-westerly and westerly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

“And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 10 otherwise Hanover Ward shall comprise so much of the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the boundary of Ward No. 2, and the boundary of Ward No. 9 opposite to the centre of Southover-street, thence in a north-westerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 9 to the centre of the road abutting upon the eastern side of ‘the Level,’ thence in a north-easterly direction along the centre of the said road to a point opposite to the centre of Elm-grove, thence in an easterly direction to and along the centre of Elm-grove to the boundary of Ward No. 2, thence in a south-westerly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.

“And I do hereby determine that Ward No. 11 otherwise ‘Lewes-road’ Ward shall comprise so much of the area of the county borough of Brighton as is contained within a line commencing from the point of intersection of the boundary of Ward No. 1 and the boundary of Ward No. 2 in the centre of Elm-grove, thence in a westerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 2 to the boundary of Ward No. 10 thence in a westerly and south-westerly direction along the boundary of Ward No. 10 to the boundary of Ward No. 9, thence in a south-westerly direction along the said boundary to a point opposite to the centre of Waterloo-street, thence in a westerly direction for a distance of two hundred and forty-two linear feet to a point opposite to the centre of Brunswick-place, thence in a northerly direction to and along the centre of Brunswick-place to a point opposite to the centre of Viaduct-road, thence in a northerly direction to the boundary of the parishes of Brighton and Preston in the Ditchling-road, thence in a northerly direction along the said parochial boundary to a point in the said boundary opposite to the centre of the old Holling Dean-road, thence in an easterly direction along the said parochial boundary of Ward No. 1, thence in a south-westerly direction along the said boundary to the point of commencement aforesaid.
