ORDER OF LONDON COUNTY COUNCIL RE-ARRANGING THE WARDS OF THE PARISH OF ST. MARY ABBOT, KENSINGTON, APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

To the Vestry of the Parish of Saint Mary Abbot, Kensington; And all whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 15 of the London County Council (General Powers) Act, 1893, it is enacted that the London County Council may from time to time for the purpose of elections of vestrymen, upon the application in writing of the vestry, or of not less than five hundred rated householders of a parish mentioned in Schedules A and B to the Metropolis Management Act, 1855, by order under their seal, rearrange the wards in such parish, and determine

the number, extent, limits, and boundary lines of the new wards, but so nevertheless that no ward shall contain less than five hundred rated householders, and that the whole number of wards shall not exceed eight, and the Council shall, in making any such re-arrangement, apportion making among the several wards the number of vestrymen to be elected for such parish, and shall in assigning the number of vestrymen to each ward have regard so far as practicable as well to the number of persons rated to the relief of the poor in each ward as to the aggregate amount of the sums at which all such persons are rated, and the number of vestrymen assigned to each ward shall be a number divisible by three; and it is also by the said Act enacted that any such Order may contain such provisions with reference to the election, rotation, and retirement of vestrymen (whether elected prior or subsequently to
