## ELECTION OF A REPRESENTATIVE PEER FOR IRELAND.

IN pursuance of an Act passed in the fortieth year of the reign of His Majesty King George the Third, entitled "An Act to regulate the mode by which the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and the Commons, to serve in the Parliament of the United Kingdom, on the part of Ireland, shall be summoned and returned to the said Parliament," I do hereby give notice, that the Right Honourable Luke Gerald, Baron Clonbrock, has been chosen, by a majority of votes, to be the Peer to sit in the House of Lords of the United Kingdom, in the room of William Charles, Baron Carbery, deceased.
