(SWINE-FEVER.)

By the Board of Agriculture.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The following Area (namely),—in the county of Huntingdon comprising the petty sessional divisions of Leightonstone, Norman Cross, and Ramsey, and such portion of the Toseland petty sessional division as lies on the left bank of the River Ouse from St. Neots Bridge,—which was declared by Order of the Board dated the twenty-first day of February, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five to be an Area infected with swine-fever, is hereby declared to be free from swine-fever, and that Area shall, as from the commencement of this Order, cease to be an Area infected with swine-fever.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.
