ORDER of the Local Government Board: District Auditor: Assignment of District and Duties: Supplemental :-

North-Eastern Counties Audit District.

Frantham Burial Joint Committee.

To John Frederick Adams. District Auditor ;-To the Grantham Burial Joint Committee ;-And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of the District Auditors Act, 1879, it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts ;

And whereas by certain Orders dated the 30th day of September, 1892, and the 29th day of October, 1894, We, the Local Government Board, certified the appointment of the said John Frederick Adams as a District Auditor, and directed that, unless We should otherwise prescribe, it should be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the County Councils of the Counties named in paragraph (1)of Article I of the first-mentioned Order, and the other Accounts referred to in that Article so far as the same might relate to a period prior to the 1st day of April, 1895, as well as the Accounts referred to in Article II of the firstmentioned Order; and We further directed that the District in which the said John Frederick Adams should act as Auditor, and which District was thereby assigned to him, should be termed "The North-Eastern Counties Audit District," and should, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article 1 of the said firstmentioned Order, comprise the area for tre time being included in the several Administrative Counties named in Schedule A to that Order; and, for the performance of the duties assigned to him by Article II of such Order, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Unions named in Schedule B to such Order, and the Districts mentioned in paragraphs (3) and (4) of the said Article II, and the Districts or areas subject to the jurisdiction of any such Authority as is mentioned in paragraph (6) of the said Article II;

And whereas by an Order dated the 23rd day of March, 1882, We, the L cal Government Board, certified the appointment of Robert Azlack White as a District Auditor, and ordered and prescribed that the District in which he should in future act as Auditor, and which was thereby assigned to him, should, until We should otherwise prescribe, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Unions named in the Schedule to that Order, and that such District should be termed "The Lincolnshire Audit District"

And whereas it is prescribed by Article 2 cf the said Order dated the 2 rd day of March, 1882, that it shall be the duty of the said Robert Azlack White to audit the Accounts of the Guardians and the Overseers specified in Nos. (1) and (2) of that Article, as well as the Accounts of the other Authorities (and of their Officers) referred to in Nos. (3) and (4) in the following terms :-

- "(3.) The several other Authorities for the "time being whose Accounts are or may be " by law subject to be audited by a District "Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas " of whose jurisdiction are for the time being "wholly situated within the said Audit " District.
- "(4.) Such of the said other Authorities whose "Accounts are or may be by law subject to "be so audited, and whose Districts or the " areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time "being partly situated within the said Audit District, as We may by Order under Seal "hereafter prescribe."

And whereas the Grantham Burial Joint Committee are such an Authority as is referred to in Article 2 (No. 3) of the said Order dated the 23rd day of March, 1882; and it is expedient that the duty of auditing the Accounts of the said Committee and of their Officers should be assigned to the said John Frederick Adams in lieu of to the said Robert Azlack White:
