On the departure of the Royal Yacht, Minute Guns were fired by the Flag Ship, and by the Saluting Battery.

Minute Guns were also fired by the Men of War anchored in Cowes Roads, on sighting the "Alberta," and the Fairway of the Harbour was kept clear by boats from the detached Squadron.

A Guard of Honour of the 2nd Battalion Scottish Rifles at East Cowes, was mounted on the Pier, under the Command of Captain H. M. Head.
