

"time being whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being wholly situated within one or more of the said Unions."

"(7.) Such of the other Authorities whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be so audited, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being partly situated within one or more of the said Unions, as We may by Order under Seal hereafter prescribe."

And whereas the Rural District Council of Tonbridge is an Authority whose Accounts are subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and the District of the said Rural District Council is partly situated within one or more of the said Unions:

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers given to Us by the Statutes in that behalf, We hereby Order and Prescribe that it shall, until We otherwise Prescribe, be the duty of the said Lawrance Hargreaves Wraith to audit the Accounts of the said Rural District Council, and of their Officers, in conformity with the provisions contained in Article III of the above-cited Order; and that for the purpose of such Audit the District of the said Rural District Council shall be deemed to be within the said South-Eastern Counties Audit District.

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 14TH APRIL 1896.)

SWINE-FEVER (INFECTED AREAS) REVOCATION ORDER OF 1896.

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Orders described in the Schedule to this Order, to the extent described in that Schedule, are hereby from and after the commencement of this Order revoked: Provided that such revocation shall not invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the Orders hereby revoked, or any of them, or affect any licence or authority granted, or any agreement made, or any right, title, obligation, or liability accrued thereunder before the commencement of this Order, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the Orders hereby revoked, or any of them, before the commencement of this Order.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the twenty-first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.

3. This Order may be cited as the SWINE-FEVER (INFECTED AREAS) REVOCATION ORDER OF 1896.
