THE Queen has been pleased to grant unto Henrietta Matilda d'Avigdor, of Princes-square, in the parish of Paddington, in the county of London, Widow and relict of Elim Henry d'Avigdor, late of Lancaster-gate, in the parish of Paddington aforesaid, Gentleman, deceased, for and on behalf of her only son, Osmond Elim d'Avigdor, of Trinity Hall, in the University of Cambridge, a minor of eighteen years and upwards, Her Royal licence and authority that he, the said Osmond Elim d'Avigdor, may, in compliance with a proviso contained in the last will and testament of Sir Isaac Lyon Goldsmid, late of St. John's Lodge, Regent's Park, in the county of Middlesex, Baronet, deceased, take and henceforth use the surname of Goldsmid in addition to and after that of d'Avigdor, and that he may bear the arms of Goldsmid quarterly with those of his own family; such arms being first duly exemplified according to the laws of arms, and recorded in the College of Arms, otherwise the said Royal licence and permission to be void and of none effect:

And to command that the said Royal concession and declaration be recorded in Her Majesty's said College of Arms.
