ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
 AGRICULTURE.

(DATED 5TH JANUARY 1897.)

(SWINE-FEVER SUSPECTED ZONES.)

THE Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 and 1896, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Contraction of Swine-Fever Suspected Zone.

1. From and after the commencement of this Order the borough of Bedford—being a portion of a district or area declared by Order of the Board dated the twelfth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six to be a Swine-Fever Suspected Zone—shall cease to be included in such Zone, and that Order shall be read and have effect accordingly.

Declaration of Swine-Fever Suspected Zone.

2. The district or area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby from and after the commencement of this Order declared to be a Swine-Fever Suspected Zone for the purposes of the Swine-Fever (Suspected Zones) Order of 1896 dated the twenty-fourth day of August, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
