

In the High Court of Justice.—Companies (Winding-up).
No. 00200 of 1896.

Mr. Justice Vaughan Williams.

In the Matter of the Companies Acts, 1862 to 1890, and
in the Matter of Thomas Edward Brinsmead and Sons
Limited.

TAKE notice, that by an Order dated the 15th day
