Now, I, the Right Honourable Sir Matthew White Ridley, Bart, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Wild Birds Protection Acts, 1880 to 1896, and for special reasons which have been placed before me in an application from the County Council for the Administrative County of West Suffolk, do hereby make the following Order:—

During the period from the 1st day of August in any year to the 1st day of March following, the taking or killing of the following kinds of Wild Birds, namely, Owls, Kingfishers, and Kestrels, is prohibited throughout the Administrative County of West Suffolk.
