Storms or gales will be signalled by the letter G, followed by two figures and one or several letters, according to the undermentioned arrangement:—

The figures indicate the directions from which the gale is expected:—

- 02 stands for N.N.E.
- 04 stands for N.E.
- 06 stands for E.N.E.
- 08 stands for E.
- 10 stands for E.S.E.
- 12 stands for S.E.
- 14 stands for S.S.E.
- 16 stands for S.
- 18 stands for S.S.W.
- 20 stands for S.W.
- 22 stands for W.S.W.
- 24 stands for W.
- 26 stands for W.N.W.
- 28 stands for N.W.
- 30 stands for N.N.W.
- 32 stands for N.

The letters indicate approximately the places threatened with a gale:—

C stands for Shantung and north coast of China.
M stands for the estuary of the Yang tse kiang, the Chusans, &c.

F stands for the Formosa Channel.

D stands for the neighbourhood of the Liu Kiu Islands.

Q stands for the south coast of China and the China Sea.

K stands for Kiuisu and the S.W. coasts of Japan.

W stands for the sea of Japan, Korea, and the west coast of Japan.

N stands for the coasts south of Newchwang and the Gulf of Pe chi li.

T stands for the coasts of Japan bordering the Pacific Ocean.
