PRESENT.

The QUEEN's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

HEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four, of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four, of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Her Majesty chapter ninety-four, and of the Act of the forty-seventh and forty-eighth years of Her Majesty chapter sixty-five, duly prepared and laid before Her Majesty in Council a scheme or representation bearing date the fourth day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England acting under the provisions of the Act of the seventh and eighth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four of the Act of the thirty-second and thirty-third years of Your Majesty chapter ninety-four and of the Act of the forty-seventh and forty-eighth years of Your Majesty chapter sixty-five, have prepared and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council the following scheme or representation for altering the boundaries of the district of Saint Luke West Hampstead in the county of Middlesex and in the diocese of London.

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Your Majesty in Council bearing date the sixth day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six and published in the London Gazette upon the tenth day of the same month ratifying a scheme of the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England prepared under the provisions of the Act of the sixth and seventh years of Your Majesty chapter thirty-seven certain portions of the parish of Saint John Hampstead and of the new parish of Emmanuel West End Hampstead both in the said county of Middlesex and in the diocese of London aforesaid were together constituted a separate district for spiritual purposes and the same was called 'The District of Saint Luke West Hampstead.'

"And whereas there is not yet within the existing limits of the said district of Saint Luke West Hampstead a consecrated church.

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said district should be altered by way of extension so that they shall include the additional portions hereinafter described of the said parish of Saint John Hampstead and of the said new parish of Emmanuel West End Hampstead.

" Now therefore with the consent of the Right Honourable and Right Reverend Mandell Bishop of the said diocese of London (in testimony whereof he has signed and scaled this scheme or representation) we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation the boundaries of the said district of Saint Luke West Hampstead shall be altered by way of extension so that they shall include all those additional portions of the said parish of Saint John Hampstead and of said new parish of Emmanuel West End Hampstead which are described in the First and Second Schedules hereunder written and are delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto appended and are thereon coloured pink and green respectively and that from and after the said day of publication as aforesaid and without any assurance in law other than such duly gazetted Order the said portions of the said parish of Saint John Hampstead and of the said new parish of Emmanuel West End Hampstead so to be included within the boundaries of the district of Saint Luke West Hampstead as aforesaid shall become and be and form part of the same district.

"And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending or proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or of any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of any of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"The FIRST SCHEDULE.

"The territory (a portion of the parish of Saint John Hampstead in the county of Middlesex and in the diocese of London) to be annexed to the district of Saint Luke West Hampstead in the same county and diocese being:—

"All that portion of the said parish of Saint John Hampstead which is bounded upon the south-west by the said district of Saint Luke West Hampstead upon the north-west by the new parish
